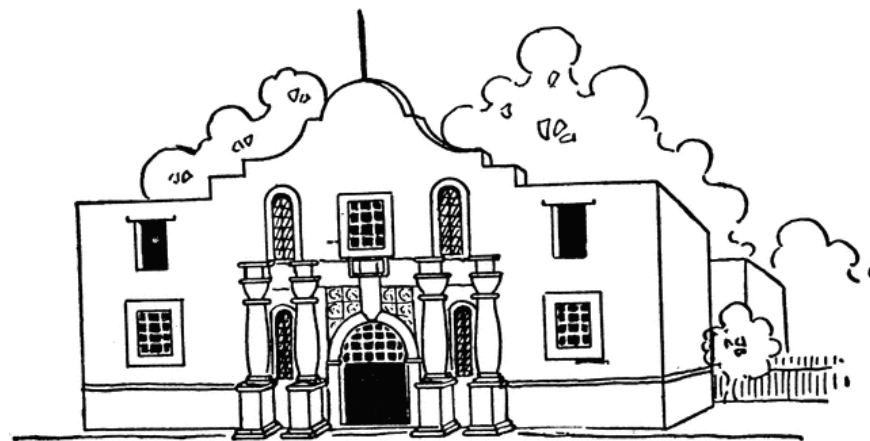

Access to Archival Databases

Access to Archival Databases (AAD) database provides online access to records in a small selection of historic databases preserved permanently in NARA.

Out of the nearly 200,000 data files in its holdings, NARA has selected approximately 475 of them for public searching through AAD. Those records identify specific persons, geographic areas, organizations, and dates. The

records cover a wide variety of civilian and military functions and have many genealogical, social, political, and economic research uses.

AAD provides:

- Access to over 85 million historic electronic records created by more than 30 agencies of the U.S. federal government and from collections of donated historical materials.
- Both free-text and fielded searching options.
- The ability to retrieve, print, and download records with the specific information that you seek.
- Information to help you find and understand the records.

The database gives you an access to: 25,000+ family and local history books, every word searchable; complete U.S. Federal Census, 1790-1930; a comprehensive subject index covering more than 6,500 genealogy and local history periodicals written in English and French (Canada) since 1800; Revolutionary War Pension and Bounty Land War-rant application files; Freedman's Bank records.

You can access this database within the library or remotely from your home computer.

Ancestry Library Edition

This database has unparalleled coverage of the U.S. and the U.K., including census, vital, church, court, and immigration records, as well as record collection from Canada and other areas. Overall dates of coverage: 1300—present.

The Ancestry Library Edition collection has approximately 4, 000 databases including key collections such as U.S. federal census images and indexes from 1790 to 1930 (every name indexed); the Map Center containing more than 1, 000 historical maps; American Genealogical Biographical Index (over 200 volumes), Daughters of the American Revolution Lineage (over 150 volumes), The Great Migration Begins: Immigrants to New England, 1620—1630, Social Security Death Index, WWI Draft Registration Cards, Federal Slave Narratives, and a strong Civil War collection. U.K. and Ireland Collection includes: Census images and indexes; Civil Registration Index, 1837—present ; Parish & Probate records, 1500's—1837. Immigration Collection includes: New York passenger list; San Francisco passenger list; New York Petitions for Naturalization index.
